Introduction:-

PHRS has conducted a 6days residential capacity building programme for district health planning and management system for the block programme manger for the 6th batch at hotel Madhuban Raipur . 27 Block coordinators from 13 district participated in the training, the training was inaugurated by Dr. Anthony Director of STATE HEALTH RESOURCE CENTRE Raipur Chhattisgarh, one of the key note address he is highlighted the importance of the capacity building programme & narrated the expected outcome by the end of the programme from each of the participant.

Objective of the programme:-

- Understanding on NRHM Goal & Objectives.*
- Understanding on the importance of Public Health and to ensure proper planning & implementation.*
- To build capacity of block manager & other stakeholders to understand the Importance of district health plan & management system at block level.*

Day wise Activities: 1st Day 2nd March 2009,

Introduction round:-

All the participants introduced themselves with their qualification & expectation with reference to beginning of the joining at their respective block. This round has facilitate by Sulakshna nandi & Suraj Baghel

Pretest:-

After introduction with BPM a pre – test was organized to estimate the level of participants. It facilitated by Suraj Baghel

Interaction with BPM: -

A discussion on the role & responsibility of the BPM on what they have done, what was their thought before joining was facilitated by Mrs Sulakshna Nandi & Dr. Kamlesh Jain

Goals of Public Health: - This session has taken by Mrs Sulakshana Nandi, she explained about public health, and importance of the public health with reference to Bhore committee, Alma Ata Declaration and Millennium Development goals.

Post lunch

Dr. Kamlesh Jain took a session on the Goal of NRHM, he elaborated on NRHM programme through an interaction with the participants he highlighted the needs of health service provider and department .the outcome stressed on , good behavior of service provider, complete treatment, Proper diagnosis of diseases. Good environment, out of pocket expenses should not be done etc. He said that NRHM is an umbrella programme where so many programme are included, it is flexible in nature. He urged the BPMs to make at least 5 -10 Gram panchayat full functions with good indicator.

Dr. Kamlesh jain also took a session on the IPHS standards for CHCs, PHCs and SHCs with government guideline.

2nd Day 25th February

Day 2nd started by recap of 1st day activities by the participant after that Dr. Megha Khobragade took a session on Tuberculosis & its problem in Chhattisgarh , she explained the objective of TB control programme and expected indicator .The problems of HIV/AIDS in Chhattisgarh and its control was also elaborated by Dr. Megha Khobragade.

Dr. Saurabh Jain (State consultant NLEP/WHO) has taken a session on Leprosy Eradication programme in Chhattisgarh; he explained sign & symptoms of leprosy for understating of BPMs. He stress Leprosy programme is important in district action plan.

Post lunch

Mr. Avinash Lumba (senior programme coordinator SHRC) updated on the MITANIN programme & its structure in the context of district health planning. Mitanin is playing an important role to make healthy “Para, Villages and Gram Panchayts” He also took a session on Village Health & Sanitation committee. Formation of committee, Members, authority, role of board member. He describe the Swasth Panchyat Yojana and 32 health indicators which is covering in the Swasth Panchayat Yojana through a PowerPoint presentation. The session was very interactive .

Discussion on Field visit:- All the participants divided in 5 groups and visited place such as Community Health Centre Abhanpur, Primary Health Centre Champaran , Sub Health Centre Nimora of Abhanpur block , VHSC – Khopra village, JSY/Mitanin – Nayak bandha village. Every group was given the tasks through a format. Day was concluded by 7.00 pm. Facilitated by PHRN team.

3rd Day 4th March 2009

Day was started by recap of 2nd day after that Dr Anthony (Director of SHRC- CG) took a session on maternal health; he explained the cause of maternal death and focus on the three delay of maternal death. He also said that more than death is happening

The Anti natal care, intra natal care and parental care is most important thing , which should be ensure by BPMs. Dr Anthony also address on the key maternal strategy, low body mass index and birth planning. It was an interactive session

After lunch field visited by all the participants.

4th Day 5th March 2009

The day was started by Mr. Praveen Khobragadey (unicef) he took a session on child health, he elaborated the strategies for child survival and health in the district plan He highlighted on the cause of child death, Neonatal mortality and he stressed on ,

- 1. Exclusive breast feeding*
- 2. Colostrums feeding*
- 3. Early initiation*
- 4. Complementary feeding.*
- 5. Trend of IMR in Chhattisgarh*
- 6. Trend in vaccination*

All those point were described in this session. He said that TT is most important for mother BPMs should ensure the supply of vaccine for vaccination day, immunization day. he also address the Anemia in Chhattisgarh and adolescent health.

Post lunch The session on Behavior change communication was taken by Mr. Dubey (Asst. director IEC- NRHM). He explained the importance of IEC , BCC activities, planning and implementation of the programme and its out come in the context of district health plan. At the ends of the day field visit experience was shared by the each group through chart paper presentation.

5th Day 6th March 2009

5th day was started by recap of 4th day after that the BCC planning Grid was explained by Mr. Sameer Garg. The session on Health Equipment Management System was taken by Mr. Purussotam Saini (HEMS), he interact with all the participants and took information about availability of equipment in the block level CHC & PHCs. He explained to the BPMs on the health equipment management system at block level. He said that all the equipment should be made ready and functional & it should not be dumped in unused place

Post lunch

The session on sensitization about adminstra & finace management was taken by Mr. Salveen Mickka (State Finance Manager – NRHM). All the financial matter was discussed in the session . After that

Mr. Sanjay sammadar has taken a session on District Health planning, He explained the importance of block health planning for district & district health planning for the state. He also said that BPMs can play an important role for the planning. In this session all the points were address which are

- *Back ground*
- *Situational analysis.*
- *Objectives*
- *Strategy.*
- *Activities*
- *Measurable indicator*
- *Budgeting*

The session on the topic of convergence was facilitated by Mr. Sameer Garg. He explained with an example of AWW, Mitanin, & ANM .

6th Day 7th March 2009

Day was started by the session on Jeevan deep samiti & Hospital reforms was facilitated by Mr. Rajesh choudhri (DPM-Durg) & Dr. Kamlesh jain . he focused on the member ship fees, user fees and untied fund & its use . He urged the BPMs to make the process for meeting of Jeevan deep samiti at block level.

The session on Malaria problem and its control has taken by Dr. Chandrawansi (Distt. Malaria Nodal officer) He explained the scenario of Malaria in the Chhattisgarh & its control programme.

Post training assignment and post training formative evaluation proforma were given to them. Feedback form was collected from the participants.

Valedictory function started at 4.15 pm where Dr Subhas Pandey (Director Immunization FHWS) Chhattisgarh was the chief guests. Three participants gave verbal feedback about the training , justified the need of an induction training, They said that they have learnt about

NRHM, BPM role & responsibilities and block programme management system, they committed that they'll put their best input to improve IMR &MMR situation finally they gave vote of thanks to SPMU, PHRN team and resource person. Dr. Megha Khobragadey & Mr. Suraj Baghel wish the participants for their best performance. After the feed back Chief guest Dr. Subhas Pandey delivered motivational speech and distributed the certificate. Vote of thanks was delivered by Smt.Sulakshna Nandi & Dr. Kamlesh Jain .
